Weather Report for the PDG 2008 for the race A1/B1 of Wednesday 16, and Thursday, 17 April 2008

1. General Situation

The ridge that has determined the weather today is attenuating. A weak perturbation reaches our region in the second half of the night to Thursday from southwest bringing many clouds, but probably no noteworthy precipitations before Thursday afternoon.

2. Weather forecast for the race

At the beginning of the race dry and some high clouds. Sky cloudy or cloud covered at the end of the night and on Thursday morning. Still some bright imperials of Foehn in the sector Lac des Dix – Verbier. High mountains can be enveloped by clouds in the morning at the most accompanied by some snowflakes.
