Provisions provided by the Armed Forces to patrols

1. General information

¹ PdG command will provide provisions to patrols at the start in ZERMATT, AROLLA and SION, as well as at refreshment points along the route and at the finish in VERBIER.

2. Provisions provided for patrols departing from AROLLA

Location	Provisions provided
Snack SION	Hot drinks; Water in bottles; 2 snacks per patrol member (e.g. cereal bar, chocolate, mixed nuts and peanuts, etc.); Bread, cheese or cheese slices.
Intermediate provisions AROLLA	Hot drinks; Sweet drinks; 1 bottle of water (500 ml); 2 snacks per patrol member (e.g. cereal bar, chocolate, mixed nuts and peanuts, etc.); Refreshments by third parties possible (according to regulation art. 41).
Refreshments at COMBE DU PAS DE CHEVRES	Refreshments may be provided by third parties (according to regulation art. 41).
Refreshments at LA ROSABLANCHE	Refreshments may be provided by third parties (according to regulation art. 41).

Refreshments at LA BARME	Hot drinks; Sweet drinks; 1 bottle of water (500 ml); Chopped fruit; 2 snacks per patrol member (e.g. cereal bar, chocolate, nut and peanut mix, etc.); Refreshments may be provided by third parties (according to regulation art. 41).
Refuelling in VERBIER	Hot drinks; Cold water in bottles; 2 snacks per patrol member (e.g. cereal bar, chocolate, mixed nuts and peanuts, etc.).
Meal in VERBIER	Meal or voucher for a meal on arrival; Hot and cold drinks and snacks.

Meals in ZERMATT	Meals at a restaurant in ZERMATT. <i>In the event of a delay, no additional meals will be provided.</i>
Small snack in ZERMATT	Hot drinks; 1 bottle of water (500 ml); 2 snacks per patroller (e.g. cereal bar, chocolate, mixed nuts and peanuts, etc.).
Refreshments at SCHÖNBIEL	Refreshments may be provided by third parties (according to regulation art. 41).
Refreshments at TÊTE BLANCHE	Refreshments may be provided by third parties (according to regulation art. 41).

4. Regulatory basis
