

VOLUNTEER CHARTER

Agreement accepted by volunteers upon registration on the website: <https://www.pdg.ch>

As a volunteer for the Patrouille des Glaciers 2026, I acknowledge and accept that my participation is subject to approval by the Organising Committee. I commit to complying with the provisions set out in the volunteer participation conditions accepted during my registration. These provisions have been established by the Organising Committee of the Patrouille des Glaciers 2026.

The volunteer commits to:

- carrying out the assigned task responsibly, out of respect for the work of others and the commitments undertaken in the name of the Patrouille des Glaciers.
- following all instructions given by the organisers regarding safety, logistics, or event-specific working methods.
- taking care of and respecting any equipment provided by the organisers.
- collaborating in a spirit of understanding, mutual respect and friendliness with all individuals involved in the organisation of the event.
- being open, friendly and respectful towards fellow volunteers and visitors. Insults, racist remarks or comments harming the dignity of others will not be tolerated.
- demonstrating courtesy, empathy, attentiveness and punctuality – please inform the designated supervisor if you are unable to attend on the official day (Day X).
- avoiding any behaviour that could endanger the safety of others.
- when registering, and as far as possible, keeping the official race day (Day X) and the following day (Day X+1) available, as the race may be postponed by 24 hours depending on weather conditions.

The organisation commits to:

- providing each volunteer with a flat-rate allowance of CHF 40 per day of presence to cover travel expenses. Volunteers are encouraged, whenever possible, to use public transport or carpooling.
- providing each volunteer with a CHF 25 per-day allowance for food and beverages during the workday. This amount will be transferred to the volunteer's bank account after the event. A rotation system for breaks will be organised within each team.
- providing accommodation in Zermatt if necessary (e.g. late deployment times requiring an overnight stay).
- giving each volunteer a distinctive item of clothing as well as a gift during the briefing.
